



Bible Study Lesson: Y'ALL READY TO DIE?

Key Bible Verse: **Psalm 39:4** — “*LORD, make me to know mine end, and the measure of my days, what it is: that I may know how frail I am.*”

Other Scriptures: **2 Peter 3:9** — “*The Lord is not slack concerning his promise, as some men count slackness; but is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance.*”

Luke 17:1-2 — “*Then said he unto the disciples, It is impossible but that offences will come: but woe unto him, through whom they come! It were better for him that a millstone were hanged about his neck, and he cast into the sea, than that he should offend one of these little ones.*”

The tragic news broke early on the morning of Monday, November 21, 2016 — reports of a deadly school bus accident in Tennessee. Five elementary school students were killed when their school bus suddenly veered off the road and hit a tree while traveling at a high rate of speed. But of course the story didn't end there. It was later learned that moments before the wreck, the bus driver had asked the students, “Are y'all ready to die?” The deadly accident was the result of a deliberate act of anger! What lessons can we learn from this unspeakable tragedy? Number one— Are we prepared to die at any moment? Number two — Every life is precious and valuable to God. Number three — God warns of punishment for all those who would offend or hurt little children. What if your life were to end abruptly today? Where would you spend eternity? As evil as that bus driver was, his question is one we all need to answer. Are you ready to die and meet the Lord today? If not, there's still time to repent of sin, turn back to God, and receive His wonderful free gift of salvation by faith in Jesus Christ! Israel in the News

Wildfires tear across Israel, Netanyahu calls arsonists 'terrorists': Wildfires tore across central and northern Israel on Thursday, forcing tens of thousands of residents to flee the city of Haifa, as leaders blamed arsonists for some of the blazes and branded them terrorists. Television pictures showed a wall of flames raging through central neighborhoods of Israel's third largest city. Firefighters doused a petrol station with water as the blaze edged closer. The fires have been burning in multiple locations for the past three days but intensified on Thursday, fueled by unseasonably dry weather and strong easterly winds. "Every fire that was caused by arson, or incitement to arson, is terrorism by all accounts. And we will treat it as such," Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu told reporters gathered in Haifa. "Whoever tries to burn parts of Israel will be punished for it severely." Internal Security Minister Gilad Erdan referred to "arson terrorism" and said there had been a small number of arrests, providing no other details. On social media, some Arabs and Palestinians celebrated the fires and the hashtag #Israelisburning was trending on Twitter.

Israeli forces kill 4 Islamic State allies in Golan Heights firefight: Israeli forces engaged in a brief but deadly fight Sunday against Syrian militiamen allied with the Islamic State, killing four militants in the fraught borderlands of the Golan Heights. It was the “first substantial fight” between Israeli soldiers and ISIS affiliates in the long-running Syrian war, said Lt. Col. Peter Lerner, an Israel military spokesman. No Israelis were injured.



National Headlines

Deadly school bus crash in Tennessee: A bus carrying elementary students home from school in Chattanooga, Tennessee, crashed on Monday afternoon, killing six children and sending nearly two dozen to a hospital with injuries, authorities said. The driver, identified as Johnthony Walker, 24, was taken into custody and faces five counts of vehicular homicide, reckless endangerment and reckless driving charges.

'Brady Bunch' mom Florence Henderson dies at 82: Actress Florence Henderson -- the iconic matriarch of the TV series "The Brady Bunch" -- has died, her manager Kayla Pressman has confirmed. She was 82. "We are heartbroken to announce the passing of our dear mother Florence Henderson from Heart Failure," the Henderson family said in a statement. "

Missing California woman found safe after three weeks: A Northern California woman missing for three weeks was released by her captors and found — bound by restraints — along Interstate 5 in Yolo County on Thanksgiving morning, authorities said. At about 4:30 a.m. officials were contacted after Sherri Papini, age 34, of Shasta County, was able to flag down a motorist. The mother of two was treated for non-life-threatening injuries. Officials said they were searching for two Latina women in connection with the abduction. They were last seen driving a dark SUV and were believed to be armed with a handgun.



Global Headlines and Prophetic World Events

Fidel Castro dead at 90: Fidel Castro, whose rise as a revolutionary made him the face of socialist rebellion for more than half a century, died Friday at age 90. His brother, Cuban president Raul Castro, made the announcement on Cuban state TV. "Today, November 25, at 10:29 p.m., the Commander in Chief of the Cuban Revolution Fidel Castro Ruz passed away," Raul Castro said in an address during the 11 o'clock news on Cuban TV. "In compliance with the expressed will of Companion Fidel, his remains will be cremated. In the early hours of Saturday 26, the funeral organizing committee will provide our people with detailed information on the organization of the posthumous Homage to the founder of the Cuban Revolution."

Powerful earthquake hits northeastern Japan: Coastal residents fled to higher ground as a powerful magnitude 6.9 earthquake sent a series of moderate tsunamis toward Japan's northeastern shore Tuesday and fueled concerns about the Fukushima nuclear power plant destroyed by a much larger tsunami five years ago.

Magnitude 7.0 offshore quake rattles Central America: A magnitude 7.0 earthquake hit off the Pacific coasts of Nicaragua and El Salvador on Thursday, promoting tsunami alerts in both Central American nations. The U.S. Geological Survey said the epicenter was about 95 miles (153 kilometers) south-southwest of the port of El Triunfo, El Salvador. The quake was felt in various points of Central America including Guatemala, Nicaragua and Costa Rica.
