Bible Study Lesson: MANIFESTATIONS OF EVIL

Key Bible Verse: **Genesis 6:1-6** - *“And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, that the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. And the LORD said, My spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years. There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown. And God saw that the wickedness of man was great in the earth, and that every imagination of the thoughts of his heart was only evil continually. And it repented the LORD that He had made man on the earth, and it grieved Him at His heart.”*

Israel in the News

Hikers discover menorah engraving in Judean hills: The Israel Antiquities Authority announced the discovery, by hikers over the Hanukkah weekend, of an ancient engraving of a menorah, a seven-branched lamp stand, on the walls of a water cistern in the Judean hills. Members of the Israel Caving Club went spelunking in a previously unexplored cave and found a cistern with dovescotes as well as iconic etchings and engravings on a nearby cave wall. They immediately reported this find to the Israel Antiquities Authority because they realized the importance and significance of their discovery. Few symbols say “Jewish” like the menorah. Instructions for the design of the lamp stand are found in Exodus 25 and it became synonymous with both the First and Second Temple eras. Experts say that to find a wall engraving of a menorah is rare. It corroborates scientific research regarding Jewish history and the demographics at the time of the Second Temple period.



National Headlines

Deadly shooting at Ft. Lauderdale airport: A military veteran opened fire in a baggage claim at the Fort Lauderdale–Hollywood International Airport in Florida Friday, killing five and wounding eight others, in a horrific scene that sent people running for their lives, officials and witnesses said. The airport was closed to departing and arriving flights following the shooting, but cargo and general aviation operations resumed at midnight. The shooter reportedly had a history of mental health issues — some of which followed his military service in Iraq — and was receiving psychological treatment at his home in Alaska.

Winter storm hits U.S. South with rare snowfall: A storm packing heavy snow, sleet and freezing rain hit the U.S. South on Friday, bringing winter weather to a region unaccustomed to it and leading to traffic snarls and widespread school closures. As much as 8 inches of snow and an inch of sleet fell on a large swath of the United States from northeast Louisiana to southern Pennsylvania.

Arrest of young black suspects in brutal Chicago attack sparks hate crime debate: Three black teens and one 24-year-old were charged with hate crimes Thursday in relation to the brutal attack of a white man with special needs. News of their arrests had sparked a fierce debate on social media over whether the assault — which was broadcast via Facebook Live — should be called a hate crime. The victim’s name has not been released, but police have identified the man as an 18-year-old from suburban Chicago who suffers from “mental health challenges” and was reported missing by his parents on Monday. His assailants reportedly shouted racially charged taunts during the assault, including “f*** Donald Trump, f*** white people,” while they held their young man captive in an apartment and physically abused him.

Long Island Rail Road commuter train derails in Brooklyn: At least 37 people have suffered non-life-threatening injuries in a New York City commuter train derailment on Wednesday during peak morning commuting hours, city officials said. Dozens of emergency crews swarmed Atlantic Terminal in the borough of Brooklyn after the Long Island Railroad train went off the tracks at about 8:30 a.m. local time inside the busy transportation hub, the New York City Fire Department said.



Global Headlines and Prophetic World Events

Blast in Syrian town on Turkish border kills nearly 50: A car bomb ripped through a busy commercial district in a rebel-held Syrian town along the Turkish border Saturday, killing nearly 50 in a huge explosion that damaged buildings and left rescuers scrambling to find survivors amid the wreckage, opposition activists said. Rescuers and doctors said the explosion was so large there were nearly 100 wounded and burned.

Heavy snow and icy weather grips Europe: Heavy snowfall and below-freezing temperatures continued to sweep the European continent Saturday, causing more than a dozen deaths, grounding airplanes and crippling ferries in Italy and Turkey. At least 10 people have died in the cold that has gripped Poland in recent days. A man also died Saturday in Belgium when his truck slid off a highway. In Italy, sub-freezing temperatures were blamed for the deaths of a half-dozen homeless people.

Mexico, U.S. sign framework on electricity grid: U.S. Energy Secretary Ernest Moniz was in Mexico Saturday to sign a framework agreement on principles aimed at building the kind of cross-border electricity market with Mexico that the United States already has with Canada.

U.S. official in Mexico shot in chest, in stable condition: A U.S. consular official in the Mexican city of Guadalajara was shot in the chest by a gunman but was in stable condition, Mexican authorities said on Saturday, prompting the FBI to offer a reward for information.
