## Bible Study Lesson: **MARCH FOR LIFE**

Key Bible Verse: **Jeremiah 1:5** — *“Before I formed thee in the belly I knew thee; and before thou camest forth out of the womb I sanctified thee, and I ordained thee a prophet unto the nations.”*

Other Scriptures: **Exodus 20:13** — *“Thou shalt not kill.”*

**Luke 2:21** - *“And when eight days were accomplished for the circumcising of the child, his name was called JESUS, which was so named of the angel before he was conceived in the womb.”*

On January 27, 2017, thousands of pro-life demonstrators gathered in our nation’s capitol near the Washington Monument for this year’s March for Life rally. Vice President Mike Pence addressed the large crowd, the first time a sitting vice president had ever done so. “Because of all of you and the many thousands who stand with us in marches like this all across the nation, ‘life’ is winning again in America,” Pence told the crowd. ## *Israel in the News*

**Netanyahu pledges to promote 'responsible policies' at Trump meeting:** Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Sunday he would present "responsible policies" in talks with U.S. President Donald Trump, signaling to the Israeli far-right to curb its territorial demands in the occupied West Bank. Netanyahu leaves for Washington on Monday and will see Trump at the White House on Wednesday for their first meeting since the Republican's inauguration last month, with the Israeli-Palestinian conflict and policy toward Iran on the agenda.



## **National Headlines**

**Sessions sworn in as U.S. Attorney General:** Vice President Mike Pence swore in Sen. Jeff Sessions as attorney general at the White House Thursday. Just prior to the ceremony, President Donald Trump announced three executive orders designed to restore safety in America. "These executive actions continue to deliver on my campaign promises," the president said. The orders instruct the Department of Justice to go after criminal cartels, to form a taskforce to reduce violent crime in the country and to implement a plan to stop crimes targeting law enforcement officials. "It's a shame what's been happening to our truly great law enforcement officers. That's gonna stop as of today," Trump said.

**Winter snow storm smacks Northeast U.S.:** A densely populated swath of the Northeast was hit with a powerful winter storm on Thursday. The fast-moving nor'easter brought close to a foot of snow and more in some areas of New England, New York, and Pennsylvania, along with strong winds and coastal flooding.

**Tornadoes touch down in southern Louisiana:** Tornadoes touched down in southern Louisiana wiping houses from their foundations and downing power lines as severe weather moved across the region. At least three tornadoes touched down — one in the eastern part of New Orleans, another near the town of Donaldsonville, and another in the town of Killian.

**Woman falls to her death inside World Trade Center Oculus:** A 29-year-old New Jersey woman plunged about 30 feet to her death off an escalator inside the famed World Trade Center transit hub known as the Oculus on Saturday morning, police said. Jenny Santos, of Kearny, was trying to retrieve a hat dropped by her twin sister while the two were on an escalator at about 5:30 a.m. when she reached too far over the railing and tumbled over the edge, a law enforcement official said.

**President Trump meets with Japanese PM Abe:** Japanese Prime Minister Shinzo Abe on Friday became the second world leader to come to the White House on a quest for reassurances from President Trump, looking to ease his fears about how his unpredictable host will manage security, trade and a rising China. Trump, who projected the confidence of a dealmaker who knows he has the upper hand, mostly gave his eager guest what he needed, including promises of ever-closer military and economic ties, as well as a partnership



## **Global Headlines and Prophetic World Events**

**More than 200 whales swim away after New Zealand stranding:** Whale lovers in New Zealand finally got some good news on Sunday after more than 200 stranded whales managed to refloat themselves overnight and swim away, while volunteers managed to save another 17 whales at high tide. More than 650 pilot whales had beached themselves along Farewell Spit at the tip of the South Island in two separate mass strandings over recent days. About 350 whales have died, including 20 that were euthanized. Another 100 have been refloated by volunteers and more than 200 swam away unassisted.

**Six dead after strong quake shakes southern Philippines:** Rescuers dug through rubble Saturday to find survivors after a powerful earthquake struck the southern Philippines, killing at least six people and sending thousands fleeing for safety. Residents of the southern town of Surigao in Mindanao island spent the night huddled in fear as aftershocks rocked the city following the 6.5-magnitude quake which struck late Friday when many people were already in bed.

**North Korea test fires another ballistic missile:** North Korea fired a ballistic missile into the sea early on Sunday, the first such test since U.S. President Donald Trump was elected, and his administration indicated that Washington would have a calibrated response to avoid escalating tensions. The test was likely to have been of an intermediate-range Musudan-class missile that landed in the Sea of Japan, according to South Korea's military, not an Intercontinental Ballistic Missile (ICBM), which the North said it could test at any time.
