DAY OF DECISION



Bible Study Lesson: NEWNESS OF LIFE

Key Bible Verse: **Romans 6:4** — “*Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. For if we have been planted together in the likeness of his death, we shall be also in the likeness of his resurrection*”

Other Scriptures: **2 Corinthians 5:17** — “*Therefore if any man be in Christ, he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.*”

Galatians 2:20 — “*I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.*”

The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the single most important event in human history. Christ's resurrection set in motion a chain of events that culminates in a new spiritual life for every believer in Him. Israel in the News

Many in Israel welcome U.S. attack on Syria as sign of more assertive key ally: Many Israeli political leaders and security experts hailed the U.S. missile strike on Syria as a sign of more forceful American involvement in the Middle East. The attack Friday was portrayed in some cases as a decisive statement by Israel's all-important ally, showing a willingness to reassert itself against Syria, Iran and the Lebanese Shiite militant organization Hezbollah, an alliance viewed by Israel as its biggest strategic threat. Russia's ability to shift the tide of the Syria civil war in the last year and a half had stoked concern in Israel that both Iran and Hezbollah will get a freer hand to set up a forward base in Syria to attack Israel.



National Headlines

Ohio man uploads video murder live on Facebook: A national manhunt is underway for a Ohio man who police say gunned down a 74-year-old grandfather and uploaded a video of the murder to Facebook. Cleveland cops have issued an aggravated murder warrant for the arrest of Steve Stephens, who allegedly walked up to Robert Godwin Sr. on Sunday and shot him in the head because he was having personal problems.

Protests turn violent at UC Berkeley campus: Supporters of the president and anti-Trump protesters clashed violently Saturday in Berkeley, Calif., on a day that numerous pro-Trump rallies took place across the country. A planned “March 4 Trump” demonstration held at the city’s Martin Luther King Jr. Civic Center Park — several blocks from the University of California at Berkeley campus — escalated after fights broke out between those who had shown up for the event and counter-protesters, which led to at least 10 arrests.

Wisconsin man captured 10 days after manifesto sent to Trump: A Wisconsin man accused of stealing an arsenal of weapons from a gun shop and sending an anti-government manifesto to President Donald Trump has been arrested after a massive manhunt, authorities said on Friday.



Global Headlines and Prophetic World Events

U.S. drops M.O.A.B. on ISIS stronghold in Afghanistan: The U.S. dropped what military officials called the “Mother Of All Bombs” (MOAB) on a remote ISIS outpost in Afghanistan, resulting in complete destruction of the Islamic State terror group’s camp.

U.S. Navy sends carrier strike force to Korean Peninsula: A U.S. Navy strike group, led

by the USS Carl Vinson aircraft carrier, made its way toward the Korean Peninsula “to maintain readiness” as Kim Jong Un’s regime in North Korea prepared to mark key anniversaries in the coming weeks with suspected missile launches.

North Korean missile launch fails: An attempted missile launch by North Korea failed when it exploded immediately after liftoff, a U.S. official says. An official said a missile was launched near Sinpo, North Korea, at 5:51 a.m. local time on Sunday, and exploded immediately.
