Bible Study Lesson: FIRE AND FURY

Key Bible Verse: **2 Peter 3:7-12** — *“But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men. But, beloved, be not ignorant of this one thing, that one day is with the Lord as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. Israel in the News

Israel lists 20 groups to be denied entry over boycott calls: Israel on Sunday identified 20 activist groups from around the world whose members will be banned from entering the country over their calls to boycott the Jewish state, stepping up its fight against a movement it views as a serious threat.

Israeli PM backs Trump critique of Palestinian UN aid agency: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Sunday that he “completely agrees” with President Donald Trump’s critique of the U.N. agency aiding Palestinian refugees, saying that UNRWA only perpetuates the problem and should cease from operating in the region. Speaking at his weekly Cabinet meeting, Netanyahu also reiterated his support for Trump’s threat to cut aid to the Palestinians.



National Headlines

Original Space Shuttle commander John Young dies: Spaceflight just lost one of its better-known icons: NASA astronaut John Young has died at the age of 87. He was best known as the commander of the first Space Shuttle mission, taking *Columbia* into orbit in 1981. However, that was just one of a series of achievements. He flew on the first manned flight of the Gemini spacecraft in 1965, traveled to the Moon twice, and played a key role in the rescue of Apollo 13 by helping to stretch out its resources. On his record-setting sixth and last spaceflight, when he flew the first Spacelab module into orbit aboard the Space Shuttle, he both avoided a mid-flight disaster and landed while an auxiliary power unit was on fire. Young was also one of NASA’s longer serving astronauts., spending 42 years at the agency.

NY airport terminal flooded as brutal cold grips U.S. East Coast: International flights were suspended into a flooded terminal at New York’s flagship airport on Sunday, flung into chaos after a water main broke during brutally cold temperatures following a deadly winter storm. Gushing water compounded meltdown at John F. Kennedy International Airport, where furious passengers have camped out for days as a result of equipment damaged by the storm and a backlog of flights. Water poured from the ceiling and the arrivals area was submerged by standing water. Ninety-four flights were cancelled at JFK on Saturday and 17 diverted, as the extreme cold and storm recovery “created a cascading series of issues.

Six people killed in wrong-way California highway crash: Six people were killed on Sunday when a vehicle going the wrong direction on a northern California highway collided with another vehicle, causing a fire that engulfed both cars, police said. The female driver of a 2013 Chevrolet going the wrong way on Interstate 5 as well as the five people in the other vehicle, a 2013 Dodge, were all pronounced dead at the scene.

Brutal cold snap stuns U.S. East Coast after blizzard: A shroud of bone-chilling arctic air covered the U.S. East Coast and Midwest on Saturday, creating dangerous conditions as tens of millions of people struggled to clean up from a blizzard that dumped deep, drifting snow in many areas earlier this week. Wind chill and freeze warnings stretched from New England to Ohio and Pennsylvania, while the National Weather Service warned of freezing rain in Missouri and areas to the northeast.



Global Headlines and Prophetic World Events

People rally in solidarity with anti-government protests in Iran: Hundreds of Iranians held rallies on Saturday in support of the anti-government protests in Iran, in cities including Washington, D.C., Stockholm, London, Paris and Berlin. About 400 people gathered in central Paris, and several hundred held a rally in front of Berlin’s Brandenburg Gate with Iranian flags, drums and banners calling for a change of government.

32 missing as tanker collides with cargo ship in fireball off China: Rescue workers were searching the waters off the east coast of China in a desperate hunt for 32 missing sailors after an oil tanker collided with a cargo ship on Saturday. The Iranian tanker, Sanchi, flying under a Panamanian flag, was a wall of flames and thick black smoke as rescuers hunted for survivors 160 miles off the coast. The tanker was carrying about a million barrels of natural gas condensate, or light oil

Thousands rescued in Spain after being trapped in cars by snowstorm: A snowstorm in Spain trapped thousands of people in their cars overnight on a highway, prompting a military response Sunday, authorities said. The Spanish army deployed hundreds of soldiers to help rescue over 3,500 motorists stranded in their cars overnight on a highway in Castille, Leon and parts of Madrid.
