Israel at war with Hamas








DAY OF DECISION

Key Bible Verse: <u>Matthew 24:9</u> — "Then shall they deliver you up to be afflicted, and shall kill you: and ye shall be hated of all nations for my name's sake."

Other Scriptures: Zechariah 14:1-4 — "Behold, the day of the Lord cometh, and thy spoil shall be divided in the midst of thee. For I will gather all nations against Jerusalem to battle; and the city shall be taken, and the houses rifled, and the women ravished; and half of the city shall go forth into captivity, and the residue of the people shall not be cut off from the city. Then shall the Lord go forth, and fight against those nations, as when He fought in the day of battle. And His feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east, and the mount of Olives shall cleave in the midst thereof toward the east and toward the west, and there shall be a very great valley; and half of the mountain shall remove toward the north, and half of it toward the south.

Israel prepares for ground offensive into Gaza after being attacked by Hamas

On the morning of Sat., Oct. 8, the citizens of Israel were suddenly and brutally attacked when Hamas fired 5,000 rockets into their country from the Gaza Strip. The Hamas terrorists targeted Jews and Americans nationwide, killing attendees at a music festival and taking hundreds of hostages. They also attacked a small agricultural community known as a kibbutz, slaughtering its Jewish members killing babies and burning others alive. In response to this evil, the Israeli Defense Force (IDF) is now preparing a ground offensive into Gaza to target and destroy members of Hamas and Islamic terror cells which are supported and funded by Iran.

Powerful earthquake hits west Afghanistan, a week after strong quakes in same region

A powerful 6.3 magnitude earthquake struck western Afghanistan on Sunday, just over a week after strong quakes and aftershocks killed thousands of people and flattened entire villages in the same province. The U.S. Geological Survey said the latest quake's epicenter was about 21 miles outside Herat, the provincial capital, and five miles below the surface. The first earthquakes that occurred on Oct. 7 flattened whole villages in Herat, in one of the most destructive tremors in the country's recent history, killing more than 2,000 people across the province. The initial quake, numerous aftershocks and a second 6.3-magnitude quake on Wednesday flattened entire villages, destroying hundreds of primitive mud-brick homes

Rite Aid files for bankruptcy

Rite Aid, one of the largest pharmacy chains in the United States, filed for bankruptcy on Sunday, weighed down by billions of dollars in debt, declining sales and more than a thousand federal, state and local lawsuits claiming it filled thousands of illegal prescriptions for painkillers.

Jordan wins nomination for House speaker election

House Republicans nominated Rep. Jim Jordan, R-Ohio., for speaker after an internal secret ballot vote behind closed-doors Friday, marking another step towards electing a new leader as the lower chamber is in its 10th day without a speaker. For Jordan to become speaker, he will still have to rally an overwhelming majority of House Republicans behind him to win a vote on the floor with 217 votes, the magic number needed to get the top job.

Ring of Fire solar eclipse

Crowds of spectators watched and cheered as they witnessed the "ring of fire" eclipse pass over parts of the U.S. on Saturday. The rare spectacle bathed millions of Americans in a lunar shadow as the moon moved between the Earth and the sun. The annular solar eclipse, as the phenomenon is known, projected a halo of sunlight across skies in Oregon, California, Nevada, Utah, Arizona, Colorado, New Mexico and Texas.
